### States

#### ***Alaska***

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit (via reciprocity with California)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Alaska CLE Board after the *Seminar*.

#### ***Arizona***

Credits Approved: The State Bar of Arizona does not approve or accredit CLE Activity for the MCLE Requirement. This activity may qualify for up to 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credits towards the annual MCLE Requirement.

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Arizona CLE Board after the *Seminar*.

#### ***Arkansas***

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit (via reciprocity with California)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. NACWA will report to the Arkansas CLE Board during the reporting period after the *Seminar*.

#### ***California***

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit (via reciprocity with California)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect California Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the California CLE Board after the *Seminar*.

### ***Colorado***

Credits Approved: 28 Credits, Including 1.8 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Colorado Notice of Accreditation at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Colorado CLE Board after the *Seminar*.

### ***Connecticut***

Credits Approved: Neither the Connecticut Judicial Branch nor the Commission on Minimum Continuing Legal Education approve or accredit CLE providers or activities. It is the opinion of this provider that this activity qualifies for up to 15.5 hours toward your annual CLE requirement in Connecticut, including 1.5 hour(s) of ethics/professionalism

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report. There is no requirement that you send in any written proof of compliance to the Judicial Branch, bar association, or Statewide Grievance Committee. The MCLE program in Connecticut is a self-reporting system. You keep track of the courses and hours that you take each year, maintain records to prove compliance with the rule for seven years.

### ***District of Columbia***

Credits Approved: Not a Mandatory CLE Jurisdiction

### ***Florida***

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Florida Continuing Legal Education Application for Course Attendance Credit and Seminar agenda. They must complete and sign the form, and then mail them to The Florida Bar Legal Specialization & Education.

### ***Georgia***

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report. NACWA will report to the Georgia CLE Board after the *Seminar*.

### ***Hawaii***

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit (via reciprocity with California)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect a Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Hawaii State Board of CLE during the reporting period after the *Seminar*.

### ***Illinois***

Credits Approved: 15.5 General Credits. 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Illinois Certificate of Attendance. If this certificate is not available at the registration table, please see a NACWA Staff Member. NACWA will report to Illinois' MCLE Board after the *Seminar*.

***Indiana***

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report at NACWA's registration desk. NACWA will report to the Indiana Office of Admissions and Continuing Education after the *Seminar*.

***Kansas***

Credits Approved: 17.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and complete the Kansas CLE Commission Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Kansas CLE Commission after the *Seminar* and send NACWA a copy of the completed Kansas Certificate of Attendance.

***Kentucky***

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Kentucky Bar Association Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. NACWA will report to the Kentucky Bar Association after the *Seminar* during the reporting period.

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit (via reciprocity with California)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect a Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Maine's Board of Overseers of the Bar during the reporting period after the *Seminar*.

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report at NACWA's registration desk and report directly to the Minnesota Board of Continuing Legal Education OASIS Portal with the event code 264521 after the *Seminar*.

**Missouri**

Credits Approved: 17.7 Credits, Including 1.8 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Missouri Bar after the *Seminar*.

**Nevada**

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report at NACWA's registration desk. NACWA will report to the Nevada CLE Board.

**New Jersey**

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Supreme Court of New Jersey during the reporting period after the *Seminar*.

**New Mexico**

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report at NACWA's registration desk. NACWA will report to the New Mexico Bar.

**New York**

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit (via reciprocity with California)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect a Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the New York State Continuing Legal Education Board during the reporting period after the *Seminar*.

**North Carolina**

Credits Approved: 14 General Credits. 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report at NACWA's registration desk. NACWA will report to the North Carolina State Bar after the *Seminar*.

**North Dakota**

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit (via reciprocity with California)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect a Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the State Bar Association of North Dakota MCLE after the *Seminar*.

**Ohio**

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect a Uniform Certificate of Attendance. NACWA will report to the Supreme Court of Ohio after the *Seminar*.

**Oregon**

Credits Approved: 13.25 General Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect a Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. NACWA will report to the Oregon State Bar MCLE after the *Seminar*.

**Pennsylvania**

Credits Approved: 11.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the Pennsylvania Certificate of Attendance and the Pennsylvania Credit Request Form at the NACWA registration desk. They must then report directly to the Pennsylvania CLE Board with the PA Certificate of Attendance and the PA Credit Request Form.

**Rhode Island**

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit (via reciprocity with California)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect a Uniform Certificate of Attendance at NACWA's registration desk. They must then report directly to the Rhode Island Bar Association CLE during the reporting period after the *Seminar*.

**South Dakota**

Credits Approved: Not a Mandatory CLE State

**Texas**

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report. NACWA will report to the State Bar of Texas MCLE Board after the *Seminar*.

**Utah**

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report. NACWA will report to the Utah State Board of Continuing Legal Education.

### ***Virginia***

Credits Approved: 11.5 Credits, including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance report. NACWA will provide attendees with the Virginia State Bar's Approval letter, which they must then file with the Virginia State Bar.

### ***Washington***

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report. NACWA will report to the Washington State Bar MCLE after the *Seminar*.

### ***West Virginia***

Credits Approved: 18.6 Credits, Including 1.8 Ethics Credit

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and collect the West Virginia Certificate of Attendance. NACWA will report to the West Virginia State Bar after the *Seminar* electronically.

### ***Wisconsin***

Credits Approved: 15.5 Credits, Including 1.5 Ethics Credit (Via Reciprocity with California)

To Receive Credit: Participants are required to sign the Attendance Report and report to the Supreme Court of Wisconsin Board of Bar Examiners after the *Seminar*.
